

Mr Warren Wong Shung Wen (Mr Wong), a public accountant (Registration No.: 01351), practising as a partner in the accounting firm Wong Partners, located at 33 Ubi Avenue 3, #07-21 Vertex, Singapore 408868, has failed to pass his revisit practice review. The PAOC had on 12 December 2018 ordered, among others, that:

- a. Mr Wong be restricted from performing any audit and reporting of financial statements of all public interest entities¹ for a period of 24 months commencing from 27 December 2018 and ending on 26 December 2020.
- b. Mr Wong be required to undergo a review² (commonly known as “hot review”) by a hot review partner approved by ACRA, for 10 audit engagements signed off by Mr Wong, each involving annual turnover greater than S\$10 million, within a period of 9 months commencing from 27 December 2018.

Arising from the above orders, Mr Wong shall not be an audit principal³ from 27 December 2018 until the end of the restriction period, and until he completes his hot review order, if this is later than the end of the restriction period.

¹ The phrase “public interest entities” as used here has the same meaning as defined in paragraphs 290.25, SG290.25A and SG290.25B in the *Code of Professional Conduct and Ethics for Public Accountants and Accounting Entities* at the Fourth Schedule of the Accountants (Public Accountants) Rules.

³ An audit principal is a public accountant who directly supervises or undertakes the overall oversight of a pupil’s acquisition of qualifying audit experience. The public accountant must have at least 5 years’ experience in public practice and must not be subject to any of the following PAOC orders:

- (i) An order prohibiting the public accountant from being an audit principal;
- (ii) A hot review order;
- (iii) A restriction order;
- (iv) A suspension order.
